Competency development fund for academic staff at OUH

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Proposals for competency development for academic staff are invited. Please refer to call and other information at the website for the [competency development fund](#).

Objective

One of the objectives in the joint research strategy for OUH and the Department of Clinical Research, SDU, is to establish more apparent and coherent career paths for researchers. The aim is, i.a., to increase the recruitment and further staff retention of the best qualified young talents. Likewise, targeting the efforts of an efficient and systematic implementation of new research results is in focus.

One of the means is to offer a systematic training in project management, research management and instruction and tools for implementation.

A total of DKK 575.000 is set aside for the fund each year.

Requirements for applicants

PhD students, postdocs, assistant and associate professors and professors employed in a combined position between OUH and SDU are eligible to apply for a grant from the fund.

Specialist doctors and other professions with specialist tasks are eligible to apply for classes in implementation. In addition to being responsible for specialist tasks, applicants must hold a PhD or Dr.Med. degree.

Eligible costs

- Courses in project management
- Courses in management and self-management
- Courses in career and talent development
- Courses in implementation

Non eligible costs

- Professional postgraduate teacher training (pædagogikum). Funding may be applied for at the Department of Clinical Research, SDU
- Transportation, subsistence expenses and meals

Assessment criteria

All applications will be assessed by an assessment committee which will estimate whether or not the abovementioned criteria are met.

How to submit an application

You must submit your application by email to ouh.forskning@rsyd.dk with the following attachments:

- Completed application form (available at the [website of the fund](#))

- Description of the class
- CV of the applicant

Your application must be written in Danish or English.

Assessment procedure

You will receive a confirmation of receipt of the application as soon as possible and no later than a week after it has been submitted.

All applications will be forwarded to the assessment committee. Applicants will receive notice of the outcome of the application approximately two weeks after the receipt of the application has been submitted except in July and weeks 7, 42, 52 and over Easter.
